



Volunteering at Calvin Christian School

Dear Calvin Christian Community,

Family volunteering at Calvin Christian School has been part of the Calvin tradition since 1961. Volunteering provides the opportunity to be involved in the daily school life of your child and their classmates. This partnership also provides meaningful connections to other families in the community. We ask each family to consider how they can be involved with one or more of the programs at Calvin Christian School.

Volunteer roles are available to fit a wide range of gifts, interests, and time. For example, participation on various planning committees offers the opportunity to serve Calvin Christian as an organization, while roles like Room Parent serve your child's class directly. There are opportunities to serve during the school day, such as Recess Monitor, as well as off school hours, including athletics and fine arts events. Some needs are recurring, such as hot lunch server, while there are many one-time opportunities including judging at a variety of school fairs.

Your family financial commitment to Calvin includes a \$200 volunteer incentive deposit. A full refund will be available when family members work a total of 20 volunteer hours. The opportunity to accumulate volunteer hours will run annually from the day after school dismisses in the summer through the last day of the following school year. Partial refunds will be calculated in 5-hour, \$50 increments.

Calvin Christian School relies on over 4000 hours from our parents on all campuses each year to provide for the many programs and resources for Calvin Christian students. We pray that as you become involved with your child's school, you experience the rich blessings of building community with fellow parents and connect with the mission of Calvin Christian School in a tangible way.
